

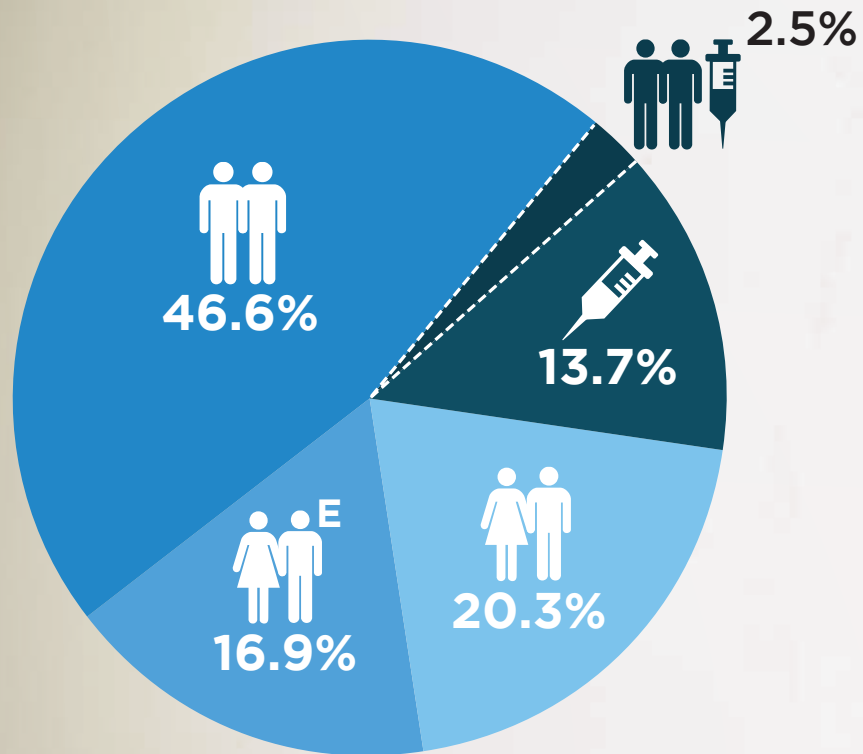

People who inject drugs



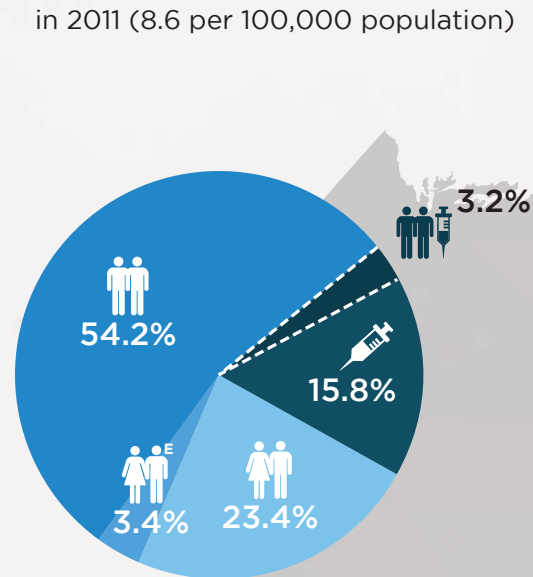
Heterosexual people, not including those born in countries where HIV is endemic



Heterosexual people born in countries where HIV is endemic

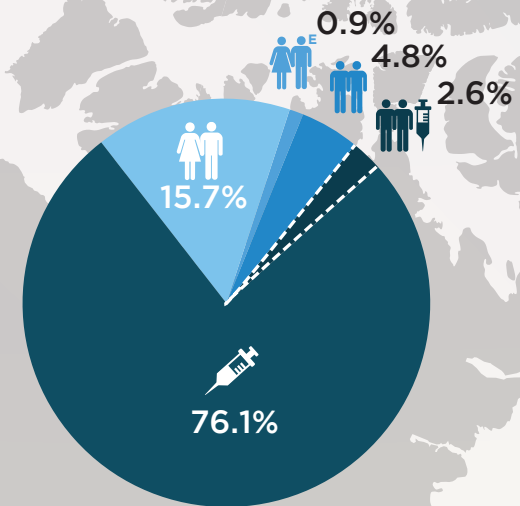
BRITISH COLUMBIA

An estimated 380 new HIV infections in 2011 (8.6 per 100,000 population)



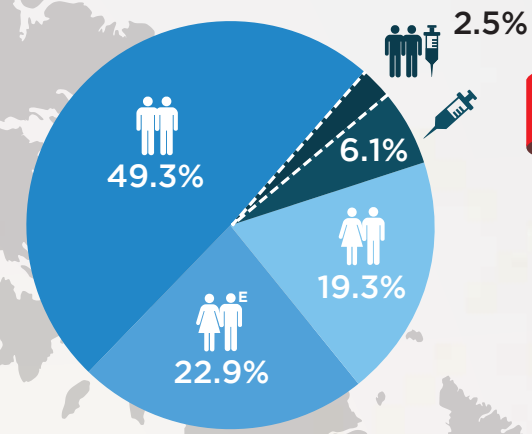
SASKATCHEWAN

An estimated 230 new HIV infections in 2011 (22.3 per 100,000 population)



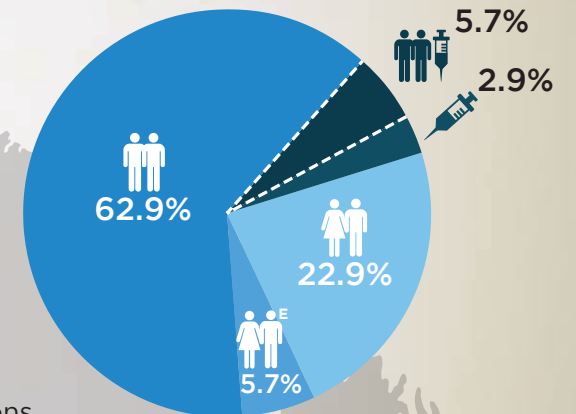
ONTARIO

An estimated 1,400 new HIV infections in 2011 (10.9 per 100,000 population)



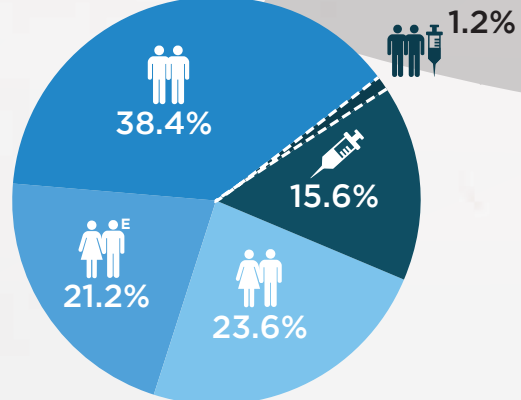
ATLANTIC CANADA

An estimated 35 new HIV infections in 2011 (1.5 per 100,000 population)



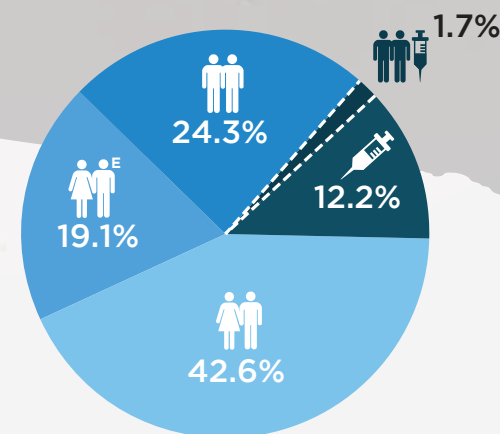
ALBERTA
